GUIDANCE NOTES

Part 1 – Please complete all details in BLOCK CAPITALS

Part 2 – Please complete the declaration if you are a UK tax payer and you pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the Fund can reclaim on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1 you give).

If your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax at least equal to the amount reclaimed by the Fund, you can cancel your declaration. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your self assessment tax return.

If you are forwarding a cheque that has not been drawn on your own bank account (you may have made a cash donation via your Lodge who have issued a cheque on your behalf) then you **must** supply written notification from the account holder certifying that their cheque is in respect of a cash donation given to them, by you, for onward transmission to the Fund.

If you do **not** pay an amount of tax at least equal to the tax that the Fund would reclaim on your donations in the tax year, please do not complete the Gift Aid declaration.

HONORIFIC ENTITLEMENTS

Brethren who contribute a minimum of £100 to the Masonic Samaritan Fund on behalf of the 2014 Festival will be eligible to purchase a Festival jewel on payment of £15.00 plus £1.00 p&p. An application form will be sent with the acknowledgement of your donation.

In addition, donations to the 2014 Festival will also count towards the existing MSF honorifics. Qualification for MSF honorifics will take account of any previous donations to the Fund before the Festival was launched. Qualification for MSF honorifics will be notified from the Fund and will be awarded as follows:

When your contributions reach the following levels you will achieve the appropriate status.	Freemasons (including tax recovered)	Non-Freemasons (including tax recovered)
Member*	£100	N/A
Vice Patron**	£300	N/A
Patron**	£600	£150
Grand Patron**	£1200	N/A

*In addition to the Festival jewel, members are entitled to purchase the MSF jewel, at a cost of £5, from the Fund's office. If you make a commitment by way of a Pledge and Banker's Order to pay £100 or more including tax, you are entitled to purchase the jewel on receipt of the initial £25. You will not however become a member until your cumulative donations amount to £100 or more. The Jewel has been designated a permanent Jewel and may be worn in Lodge Meetings.

** These additional honorifics will be denoted by a Bar for the Jewel for Freemasons and a certificate for Non-Freemasons. These will be issued free of charge.
